Abstract:

This study investigates the verbs in IPA and EAs with respect to: (1) their meanings, (2) the verb groups they belong to and (3) their distribution in the two cognitive moves i.e. *provisionary clause* and *qualification clause*. As far as the Persian translation is concerned, the translation strategies, the distribution of the Persian counterparts in the provisionary clauses and qualification clauses and the verb groups they are taken from are studied as well. Besides, modals as the indispensible participants of verbs in the official documents which are assigned to intensify or decrease the extent of obligation, certainty and willingness in relation with the meanings contained in the verbs are taken into account in respect of: (1) their meaning components, (2) the modal groups they belong to and (3) their distribution in the provisionary clause and the qualification clause. Furthermore, the strategies adopted for the translation of English modals are examined.

In order to accomplish the objectives, the verbs and the modals detected in the selected data were grouped respectively on the basis of Burton-Roberts classification (1997) and Palmer's (1986). Their meaning components and their distribution in the two above-mentioned moves were illustrated in the separate tables. In the next step, the strategies applied for their translation were examined. Last, the verbs replaced in the translation were discussed in terms of the verb groups they belonged to and their use in the cognitive moves. The findings revealed that the most frequent verbs in the qualification clauses were the monotransitive verbs and in the next place the complex transitive verbs. Moreover, the most frequent translation strategy as to both verbs and modals was the literal translation. However, there were cases in which the respective verbs and modals were rendered by the options from a distinct linguistic category and cases in which the verbs were replaced with a verb plus another item for instance noun.
